

Where to promote volunteer opportunities

Finding great volunteers starts with spreading the word in the right places

Try a mix of online and local options to reach different people in your community.

01 Online

- Post on your **club's website** and **social media pages**.
 - Share in your **newsletter** or add a short note in your **email signature**.
 - Use free volunteer platforms such as **Volunteering WA, SEEK Volunteer, and GoVolunteer**.
 - Connect with local **community or interest groups online** (e.g. Facebook groups).

02 Within your club

- Ask **current members, players, and families** directly.
 - Include **volunteer opportunities in your club updates** or on your noticeboard.
 - Host a **“bring a friend” day** or casual coffee catch-up for volunteers.
 - Encourage existing volunteers to **invite someone they know**.

03 In the community

- Share information with **local schools, TAFEs, or universities**.
- Put **posters or flyers** up in places like libraries, gyms, cafés, and community centres.
- Connect with **local businesses, disability service organisations, or places of worship**.
- **Attend local events or fairs** with a small booth or display about your club.
- Contact your **local volunteer resource centre** for support.
